New prescription? You can send it to us in one of three easy ways.

- 01 **Ask your doctor.** Have them send a 90-day supply of your prescription electronically to Express Scripts® Pharmacy. **(This is the fastest way to get your medication!)**
- 02 **Go online.** Visit express-scripts.com/rx, log in to your account, and click the “Request an Rx” button on the right side of the home page.

- 03 **Call us.** Dial the number on the back of your ID card, and we’ll contact your doctor for you.

Current prescription eligible for home delivery?

Once you log in to your account, you may see existing prescriptions in your dashboard that are eligible for home delivery.

If you have refills available, simply click on them to order and set up payment. **We’ll contact your doctor and take care of the rest.** You can let them know we’ll be reaching out, so they’re prepared with your information.

Or you can call us using the number on the back of your ID card.

What medications can be delivered?

Most maintenance medications (those you take regularly for an ongoing condition) are eligible for home delivery in a 90-day supply.



And that's it!

Once we receive your prescription, you can expect your medication to be delivered to your chosen location in discreet packaging within 5–7 days. Standard shipping is included at no cost, but you can get it expedited for a fee.³

If there are any delays, we'll let you know.

The first order of any prescription may take longer to process, but the following refills will be quicker.

Before we can ship your medication, we might need additional information from your doctor. If any issues arise, we'll reach out with specific information on what we need from you to help resolve them.

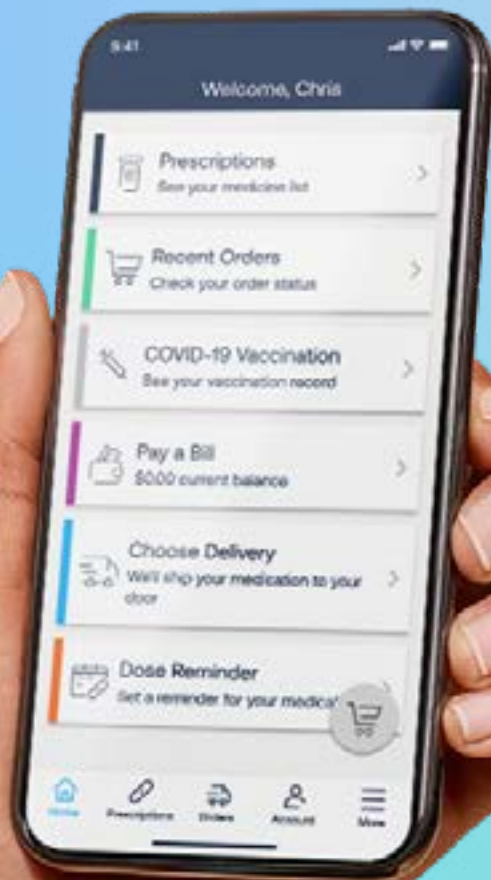

What's the difference between a refill and a renewal?

Knowing the difference between a prescription refill and a prescription renewal can help you make the right decision the next time you're running low on medication.

Refill: An order of a new supply of a current medication you are taking. If you're eligible for a refill, you can get one without having to ask your doctor.

Renewal: A new prescription for a medication you are already on. When you're out of eligible refills, you'll need to ask your doctor how to get a renewal. (If you don't need a new appointment to see your doctor, we can reach out to them on your behalf for a new prescription.)

More ways to pay.



Three convenient options to pay for your medication.

01

Pay online.

Use your debit card, credit card, checking account, or PayPal account to easily pay online.

02

Pay automatically.

Sign up for Autopay to set up an automatic payment each time a prescription ships. To help you manage your budget, you can even set a maximum amount that can be charged to your account or card. If a payment is over that amount, we will check with you before processing the payment.

03

Pay in three monthly installments.

With our Extended Payment Plan, you can split the total cost for eligible prescriptions into equal credit or debit card payments over three months (with no service fee). Your first installment payment will be processed when your medication ships.
